

**Dixons Croxteth Academy would like to share the information below about accredited online short courses focused on SEN and young people's wellbeing, provided by The AIM Group:**

The government has funded free Level 2 CACHE accredited online short courses focused on Special Educational Needs (SEN) and young people's wellbeing. These courses are fully funded through the Adult Education Budget (AEB), ensuring no cost to learners or schools. Courses are completed online within 12-20 weeks at the learner's convenience. Upon completion, learners receive a certificate from the awarding body and can then access another subject.

**Course Information and Structure:**

- Courses are delivered via an online e-learning platform.
- Learners have 12-20 weeks to complete the course.
- Each learner receives individual login details and can log in and out at their convenience.
- Each learner is assigned a tutor who provides support and grades their work.
- No exams or essays; all assessments are Q&A based.
- Learners can complete multiple courses, but one at a time.
- Upon completion, learners receive a Level 2 certificate (equivalent to GCSE Grade C).

**Minimum Requirements:**

- Must be 19 years or older.
- Not currently enrolled in another government-funded course (including apprenticeships).
- Must have resided in the EU/UK for the past three years.
- Must have access to a laptop, computer, or tablet at home.

- Neuroscience in the Early Years (0-7)
- Understanding Children and Young People's Mental Health
- Distressed Behaviour in Children
- Adverse Childhood Experiences
- Counselling
